Dear Treasurer:

This letter is prompted by the Commission's preliminary review of the report referenced above. This notice requests information essential to full public disclosure of your federal election campaign finances. **Failure to adequately respond by the response date noted above could result in an audit or enforcement action.** Additional information is needed for the following 3 item(s):

1. Your report discloses Coordinated Expenditures on Schedule F supporting Line 25 of the Detailed Summary Page. Please note that Coordinated Expenditures are made by National and State party committees on behalf of their candidates in connection with the General Election, including House, Senate, and Presidential nominees. Please amend your report to clarify the nature of these expenditures and report them as either an in-kind contribution to each federal candidate on Schedule B supporting Line 23 or as an Independent Expenditure on Schedule F supporting Line 24 of the Detailed Summary Page.
2. Schedule F supporting Line 25 of the Detailed Summary Page discloses a coordinated expenditure(s) on behalf of "KENNEDY, ROBERT, F Jr.," which appears to have been made after the general election date. Please be advised that if a service is provided or a communication is aired in one reporting period and the payment is made in a later reporting period, the coordinated expenditure should be reported as a memo entry on Schedule F when the service is provided or the communication is publicly disseminated or distributed, and on a Schedule D if it is a reportable debt under 11 CFR §104.11. When the payment for the coordinated expenditure is made, the report should show a payment on Schedule F and the same payment on Schedule D, if applicable.

Please amend your report to provide further clarifying information regarding the

coordinated expenditures disclosed after the general election date.

3. Itemized coordinated expenditures must include a brief statement or description of why the expenditures were made. Please amend Schedule F of your report to clarify the following description(s): "Administrative Business Services," "Professional Services," "Unitemized AMEX Expenditures." For further guidance regarding acceptable purposes, please refer to 11 CFR §104.3(b)(3).

- Schedule F discloses Coordinated Expenditure Made by Party Committees. For your information and consideration when preparing future filings, national party committees and state party committees may make special expenditures in connection with the general election campaigns of federal candidates. These coordinated party expenditures do not count against the contribution limits but are subject to a different set of limits, as explained. Additionally, coordinated party expenditures must be made with federally permissible funds only.

Coordinated means made in cooperation, consultation or concert with, or at the request or suggestion of, a candidate, a candidate's authorized committee, or a political party committee. Any reference to a candidate, or a candidate's authorized committee, or a political party committee includes an agent thereof. (11CFR § 109.20 (a))

Any expenditure that is coordinated, but that is not made for a coordinated communication or a party coordinated communication, is either an in-kind contribution to, or a coordinated party expenditure with respect to, the candidate or political party committee with whom or with which it was coordinated and must be reported as an expenditure made by that candidate or political party committee, unless otherwise exempted. (11CFR § 109.20 (b))

The national committee of a political party may make coordinated party expenditures in connection with the general election campaign of any candidate for President of the United States affiliated with the party. (11CFR § 109.32 (a) (1))

Please note, you will not receive an additional notice from the Commission on this matter. Adequate responses must be received by the Commission on or before the due date noted above to be taken into consideration in determining whether audit action will be initiated. Failure to comply with the provisions of the Act may also result in an enforcement action against the committee. Any response submitted by your committee will be placed on the public record and will be considered by the Commission prior to

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taking enforcement action. **Requests for extensions of time in which to respond will not be considered.**

Electronic filers must file amendments (to include statements, designations and reports) in an electronic format and must submit an amended report in its entirety, rather than just those portions of the report that are being amended.
